- (c) Applicants for Weekend/Block Release Programmes must attach Confirmation of Employment letters that include their duties and duration of employment on current job.
- (d) All programmes are offered on Weekend Class basis except for MCom Professional Accounting and Corporate Governance which is also offered on Block Release in Harare and whose first (1st) Block Release Session will run from 13-26 July 2020 and the second (2nd) Block release Session will run from 10-23 August 2020.
- (e) Weekend classes will be conducted from 17 July 2020 to 17 October 2020.
- (f) Applicants must clearly indicate on the Application Form that they are applying for the Harare Cohort or Bulawayo Cohort.

- (g) Programmes with the minimum accepted number of students will be allowed to commence.
- (h) The closing date for submission of completed application forms is Friday, 3 July 2020.
